Dear Mr. President,

Abolition of nuclear weapons and realization of eternal peace is the earnest wish of the people of Japan, the only nation in the world which suffered from the atomic bombings. It is also a sincere wish of 9 million citizens of Kanagawa Prefecture.

It was found that during the period between July and September last year, your country conducted the 6th subcritical test since your inauguration.

It is hardly understandable that, while setting a goal of realizing a world free of nuclear arms, your country continues subcritical tests. The tests have been carried out and later revealed through the media. This has been repeated in spite of our protest, and we feel strong resentment against the fact.

With this background, we can not but question your vision of a world without nuclear weapons.

In order to achieve nuclear disarmament and everlasting peace of the world, the Kanagawa Prefectural Government and all the municipalities within the prefecture hereby express our opposition against all forms of nuclear tests by any country. We strongly request that your country, as a responsible nuclear state,



never conducts nuclear tests in the future.
